- Nickajack's Foundation (NEF) has consistently raised over \$60,000 in donations for the past 4 years through the annual BACK the JACK Campaign, the Great Skate event in the fall, and the Pajama Jam Dance party in early Spring.
- The Foundation funds are put to work in the school immediately at the end of the campaign in the form of curriculum and technology enhancements, school-wide reading programs, iPad mini carts for each grade level and to fund the teacher grant program.
- The Foundation awarded over \$10,000 in teacher grants in December of 2015.
- The Nickajack School Vision: "Respectful, Responsible, Role Models." This message can be seen and heard in practice throughout the school building.
- NES utilizes the Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports program(PBIS) in order to support the school's vision statement.
- NES is one of the few schools with direct access to the Silver Comet Trail. Classes get to utilize this amazing resource during PE, after-school clubs, or within their regular curriculum.
